## Frequently Asked Questions

- What age range does the camp cater for?**  
The 2011 camp will cater for ages 11 to 22 inclusive.
- What standard does the camp cater for?**  
The camp caters for standards from beginners to players in National teams. This is done by having a development group and an advanced group.
- Does the camp welcome girls as well as boys?**  
Yes we do.
- What can I do to prepare myself for the camp?**  
You can prepare yourself for the camp by working on your fitness levels before attending, not wearing new boots for the first time and not playing without socks!
- What can I expect to be doing on a daily basis?**  
See daily schedule below.
- Is there medical provision at the camp?**  
Yes, we have state enrolled nurses on campus and can call upon a local GP and Physio if needed. The local hospital is only 5 minutes away.
- Where is the accommodation?**  
The accommodation is located at the Hoops Basketball Centre and Furness Academy.
- Where are the meals?**  
For all residents, 3 meals per day will be provided in the canteen at Furness Academy. Non residents are provided with lunch and dinner but not breakfast.
- What are the arrangements for security at night time?**  
There are residential staff on duty every night.
- Is smoking allowed?**  
No, the centre and Academy are both no smoking zones. Any camper caught breaking this rule will be sent straight home.
- Is there a camp shop on site?**  
Yes. The shop is open all day selling sweets, drinks, hot dogs, buns, fruit etc. There is also a sports shop selling basketball shorts, jerseys and other assorted basketball goods.
- What should I do about valuables?**  
We suggest that you do not bring any valuables as we cannot be responsible for them.
- What should we do about spending money?**  
Money should be deposited in the camp "bank". From that point on, anything purchased from the shop is signed for and monies owed deducted from your account at the end of the week. All remaining monies will be returned. This removes the need to carry money around at the camp.
- What do you do about bad behaviour?**  
Any behaviour detrimental to anyone at the camp, including oneself will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the camp without refund.
- Do I need insurance?**  
We recommend that you take out your own insurance against cancellation as no refunds will be given if you do not attend.
- Are there any camp souvenirs?**  
Every camper will receive a free Eurocamp kit. There will be an Official Camp photograph taken by a professional photographer available to buy. For 2011, Eurocamp T Shirts and Sweatshirts can be purchased by pre order. Details will be included in your confirmation letter.

**An £70 non refundable deposit must accompany every application to ensure reservation. Please be sure to include an E Mail address for confirmation of your booking. All campers will receive joining instructions approximately 4 weeks before camp.**
